


Using FlashPoint to convert PowerPoint to swf Flash

Note: FlashPoint should be installed on one PC ONLY.



When FlashPoint is installed, you will find a tab called FlashPoint in the toolbar at the top of the PowerPoint software.


1. To convert your PowerPoint presentation to a Flash (.swf) file, open your PowerPoint presentation and click on the **FlashPoint** tab.
2. Click on **Convert PowerPoint to Flash**, and click **Next**.




3. Select **Convert to Single Flash File** and click **Next**.



4. Under **Layout** click **Simple**.
5. Under **Play Mode** select **Loop presentation** and then click the **Advanced** button.



6. Under **Miscellaneous** make sure that **Mute...** and **Hide Presented by FlashPoint** have a check mark.
7. Click **OK**.



8. Click **Next** until the .swf file is created.

By default FlashPoint places the .swf in the same directory as your original PPT file.
