



What is a Screen Lock?

A screen lock is a security feature that helps protect your mobile device in case you lose it or the device is stolen. A screen lock prevents an unauthorized individual from accessing your device by requiring a specific action to unlock it.

Examples of Common Screen Locks:


Password




Numerical Code or PIN

- Be sure to configure your screen lock so it automatically locks after a short period of inactivity.
- If you use a PIN, password, or swipe pattern, use one that is unique and hard to guess.
