

KVVAPRO – Aid Property Code Validation Table

The aid property code validation table is used for defining properties which will be used for classifying Fund Codes, to assist with Aid Fund selection, and to help provide for better reporting of institutional data. A given aid fund can have multiple property codes of different types; if required, properties can be changed each aid year and can be corrected once added. They are hierarchical so you can report on the 'parents' (e.g. you could report all loans from Ontario or all loans from Canada would include all provinces).

ACKABLE	Award requires stewardship	Award requires some type of stewardship either from the institution, student or both
AIDTYPE	Aid Type	Type of funding provided by the aid fund.
BORROWTYPE	Borrower Type	Used to indicate when the borrower of a specified loan fund is not the student.
FUNDGROUP	Fund Group	Grouping of aid source to which this fund belongs. To be used for reporting.
GEOSOURCE	Geographic Source	Geographic Source
INSACKTYPE	Acknowledgment method used by institution	Type of acknowledgment used to communicate with donor
NOTIFY	Notification	Send e-mail notification to recipient of award
NULLPROP	Null property (system required)	This aid property is null.
PGMSTAGE	Program Stage	Award type related to student's stage in their program
PROCESSOR	Processing Unit	Processing Unit
PURPOSE	Purpose of Award	Purpose of Award
STUACKTYPE	Acknowledgment required from student	Student required to send acknowledgment to donor
