

This Roomtable is a list of classroom space maintained by the University Class Schedule office (UCSO) in ARRO. It was developed because we needed a handy reference to all the classrooms. It is based on the room lists used by Schedule 25/25E to book rooms for courses. Therefore, the list of rooms on Banner Class Schedule should match the Roomtable! It SHOULD contain all rooms used for academic purposes at McGill. If you know of any room that is used for courses that is NOT on the room list, or if you find a discrepancy between the Roomtable and the roomlist on Class Schedule, please contact the UCSO.

Adding a room to the Roomtable (and therefore, to Class Schedule) does not mean the room can be used by the whole campus! Departmental rooms are always blocked out for the exclusive use of their departments - permission to use them must always be obtained from the Roombooking Contact.
