HOW TO VIEW COURSE AND GPA INFORMATION BY TERM IN BANNER SIS Term Sequence Course History Form (SHATERM)

General:

The *Term Sequence Course History Form* is a query only form that permits the user to see the student's progress on a termby-term basis. A general student record must exist for the individual in order to access this form.

It is not possible to enter or execute a query on this form. No changes can be made to any field.

Check List:

Before you proceed, you must have the following information:

- Student Identification Number
- Course Level (for the courses whose term & GPA information you intend to view)

Remember: The bottom left of the form displays errors and warnings. This area is referred to as the auto-hint line and should be consulted if you are experiencing any problems. Even if you are not experiencing difficulties you should always keep an eye on this bar, especially if you are updating fields, as it provides important information such as warnings and errors that do not necessarily block your progress.

Accessing the "Term Sequence Course History Form" (SHATERM)

Type the name of the form SHATERM in the Direct Access field.
