

HOW TO DEFINE A PROGRAM RULE IN BANNER SIS Program Definition Rules Form (SMAPRLE)

General:

The *Program Definition Rules Form* is used to define a program rule. Details in the program rule tell the rest of the system whom the program is intended for, and provides specific processing information. The program rule must be defined before the program's requirements can be defined and/or before the program can be attached to a curriculum rule.

Remember: The bottom left of the form displays errors and warnings. This area is referred to as the auto-hint line and should be consulted if you are experiencing any problems. Even if you are not experiencing difficulties you should always keep an eye on this bar, especially if you are updating fields, as it provides important information such as warnings and errors that do not necessarily block your progress.

Accessing the "Form" (SMAPRLE)

Type the name of the form **SMAPRLE** in the Direct Access field.

The adjacent screen will appear:
