General:

The Schedule Pre-requisite & Test Score Restrictions Form is used to maintain the test scores and pre-requisite restrictions at the Schedule level.

Check List:

Before you proceed, you must have the following information:

- Term Code
- Course Reference Number

Remember: The bottom left of the form displays errors and warnings. This area is referred to as the auto-hint line and should be consulted if you are experiencing any problems. Even if you are not experiencing difficulties you should always keep an eye on this bar, especially if you are updating fields, as it provides important information such as warnings and errors that do not necessarily block your progress.
