

How to query Section Information (SSASECQ)

SSASECQ is a query form used primarily for identifying the CRN for one or many sections of a course. The form can be accessed using the Direct Access field or by clicking the drop arrow to the right of the CRN field in the key block of SSASECT. Queries can be formulated using any of the fields simply by entering the appropriate data and/or wildcard character and then executing the search command.

Initiating a query From the key block of SSASECT, clicking the drop arrow for the CRN field igschedule SSASECT 7.3.0.1 [1.20] (TRAIN7)

Query Example A search for all sections under the subject heading of Anatomy could be found by entering the subject code (ANAT or ANA%) in the subject field.



In this example the query was initiated from the key block of SSASECT where the term (200709) had been entered, so the term was forwarded into the query form. An execution of this query would then yield the following result:



All fields with available data are then populated for each record that matched the criteria set out in the search. Searches can be performed based on combinations of any of the fields. Obviously, the more criteria input, the greater the restrictions on matching results. In this case, there are more than two records, as indicated by the scroll bar handle's size. This example represents a broad search, but adding a course number would have restricted the results further, as would cross list codes, link codes schedule types, etc.

from anotherIf the query is initiated from another form, Double clicking on any record
will return that record to the originating form. In the example above, this
would return the CRN number 762 to the key block of SSASECT where the
query was initiated. If SSASECT was opened using Direct Access, then the
search results cannot be returned to any other form automatically.

Additional	A query using SSASECQ can also be initiated from the Section number field
queries	of SSASECT by double clicking in this field. This can be useful if you wish to
